Métis Nation – Saskatchewan pleased to announce Second year of funding for post-secondary Métis students

May 27, 2020 – Saskatoon, SK – After an incredibly successful year of offering funding for 461 post-secondary Métis students, Métis Nation – Saskatchewan (MN-S) is proud to say that year two is in place and ready for the 2020–21 school year.

Wholly funded by MN–S and administered by Gabriel Dumont Institute (GDI), the Métis Nation Saskatchewan Post-Secondary Education Program (MN–S PSEP) was introduced to promote a strong Métis Nation by supporting the higher aspirations of Métis students with a thirst for knowledge.

MN-S President Glen McCallum said, “Part of building a strong Métis Nation in this province is by empowering our Métis youth, encouraging them to dream big and fill the voids in industry, science, engineering and agriculture. Education is key to self-determination, what we accomplish today will be for them to build on tomorrow.”

MN–S congratulates the 461 Métis students who benefitted from year one of the program and looks forward to another successful term.

The MN–S PSEP is available to Métis citizens or to those who have started the process of obtaining Métis citizenship. No student is automatically eligible for this program.
