- Work with each Region on housing report on COVI-19 response
- Follow up with Metis citizens on housing program supports
- Schedule meetings for MN-S housing team meetings
- Support housing case managers on collection of Metis organizations to support the most vulnerable to homelessness
- Attend training held by MN-S in all department
- Assist regions on housing development projects
- Assist Case manager is linking Métis Citizens and caregivers to a range of community resources, including housing, health, education, life skills, clothing, food, transportation, etc.
