RESOLUTION (Recorded as #MNLA211128-01 in the MNLA Minutes):

BE IT RESOLVED THAT that the Métis Nation Legislative Assembly (MNLA) direct the Minister of Justice and the Provincial Métis Council (PMC) to advertise for, select and work with an independent non-partisan Commissioner to complete the Métis Local review process, in accordance with Resolution #MNLA211127-06 adopted on November 27, 2021, and report back to the MNLA at its next sitting, with consideration being given first to a person of Métis ancestry; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Commissioner's report be available to be used during the Constitutional Reform Process.
