WHEREAS the Métis Nation Legislative Assembly (MNLA) possesses the authority to enact rules governing its own procedures); and

WHEREAS it is desirable that the MNLA has regulations and rules in place governing the conduct of its own procedures and there are currently no such rules and regulations in place;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the MNLA directs that the Métis Nation - Saskatchewan government prepare written rules and procedures governing the conduct of MNLAs to be brought back to the Assembly for approval at its next sitting.
