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#### 2) SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENTS

The Back to Batoche Festival is seeking a qualified company to supply food & beverage for the **ELDER'S LODGE**. The Back to Batoche Festival is held July 21-24, 2022 at Batoche SK. This event is of vital importance to the Métis people from across Canada and the homeland. The vendor is asked to submit a proposal for the following:

Supplies and duties include but are not limited to:

- Contractor is to supply all food required for Elder's Lodge for three (3) meals per day for duration of festival
  - o Must follow Canadian Food Guidelines for healthy eating – gluten friendly and diabetic options must be available
  - o Menu must be included with tender submission
    - Breakfast – light/continental with protein options
    - Lunch – hot lunch options considering dietary needs of elders (gluten sensitivities and diabetic options)
    - Supper – three (3) course meal with dietary restriction options (gluten, diabetic etc)
- Contractor is to provide all catering services for Elder's Lodge
- Contractor is to provide cleanup services following each meal
- Contractor to provide cleanup pre, during and after event of all areas – dining room, prep area, kitchen and washrooms
- Refreshment breaks – water, tea, coffee, fresh fruit and healthy snacks to be provided between meal periods
- Contractor to supply signup method for each meal for Elder's
- An Elder is considered age 65+. Contractor is encouraged to ask for ID.

The Elder's Lodge sees approximately 300 people per meal per day.
