The Back to Batoche Festival is seeking a qualified contractor for **WASTEWATER MANAGEMENT & POTABLE WATER SUPPLY** services for the event. The Back to Batoche Festival is held **July 20-23, 2023** at Batoche SK. This event is of vital importance to the Métis people from across Canada and the homeland. The vendor is asked to submit a proposal for the following:

Supplies and duties include but are not limited to:

- Monitor levels in the wastewater tanks to ensure proper operation and pump out wastewater if system fails
- Contractor will provide all materials and supplies required for successful wastewater and fresh water supply management
- Fill potable water tanks (approximately 10,000 imperial gallons) prior to event, monitor levels throughout the event and refill when necessary to ensure a constant supply of potable water in all tanks
