

## Métis Nation–Saskatchewan Youth Update Form: Request for Card

## Important information:

• This form is for Youth Citizens currently between the ages of 12-15 years old; requesting to replace their Youth Certificate with a Metis Citizenship ID Card. The card will expire when they turn 16 when it's time to do a Youth to Adult update. This is when they sign permissions to agree and consent to the information and permissions their parent/Legal guardian signed on their behalf to register.

## Youth Update Card Requests can be completed in a registry office or by email. What will be needed

- A recent passport-quality <u>photo</u> taken by our staff or taken by yourself
- Copy of parent/guardian's valid <u>Government-</u> <u>Issued Photo ID</u>
- Copy of youth's valid <u>Saskatchewan Health Card</u>
- Copy of this completed form, that updates and verifies your contact and identifying information
- Copy of name change or gender change document(s) if required

Youth Citizen must sign within the box using black ink or draw digitally. The signature/mark will appear on their card.
