Métis Nation—Saskatchewan (MN—S) is creating a series of guidebooks and other resources to support Métis people as they interact with the healthcare system.

The Ability-Based Care Guidebook team invites Métis Citizens with disabilities, and their family members and caregivers, to share your stories and experiences. Your participation will help us determine the format and content of the guidebook!

Examples of disabilities include but are not limited to:

- Cerebral Palsy
- Deafness/Hearing Impairments
- Impaired Vision/Blindness
- Intellectual disabilities (can either be congenital
 [e.g. you are born with it] or acquired from an accident or injury)
- Neurodevelopmental motor disorders

Ways to participate include:

- In person or over phone one-on-one conversations about your experiences with disability and accessing ability-based care services.
- Submitting written statements/stories about your experiences.
- Reviewing and giving feedback on the draft documents via email.
